### May It Please the Court Club Visits YMCA Kinderwrap Program

Scotch Plains, NJ, May 18, 2010 – On Tuesday, April 27, UC’s May it Please the Court Club, concluded their year with an event at the YMCA Kinderwrap Program. May it Please the Court provides additional information and activities for any student who has an interest in a career in law or in taking UC’s mock trial course. This year, the club, along with its moderator, Mrs. Kim Leegan, worked with Mrs. Cohen’s Kinderwrap program at the Fanwood-Scotch Plains YMCA to educate the kindergarteners about the job of a lawyer. The club designed a coloring book for the students that depicted lawyers and things one might see in a courtroom. On April 27<sup>th</sup> students from May It Please the Court visited Mrs. Cohen’s class and performed a trial version of the Three Little Pigs. Club members played the roles of Judge Mother Goose, the Big Bad Wolf and his attorney, Curly Pig and his attorney, the Bailiff, and Jack Smith, a witness for the Pig. At the end of the trial the Kinderwrap class unanimously voted that the Wolf was guilty of trying to eat the pig.
